1.	The School has all classrooms with sizes of 400 to 500 ft in place of minimum 500 sq ft and above.	All the classes are above 500 sft. Earlier entry was clerical error.
2.	As per the IC video ref time 0:07 & 0:14, HT lines are seen passing through the school's premises, which may pose a serious safety hazard.	The poles have removed and placed of compound wall
3.	The school has not submitted the No Objection Certificate to be issued by State Education Department	NOC has obtained from Govt of Tamilnadu Department of School Education
4.	As per the land certificate, Para -I, Sri Vidya Vihar Educational and Charitable Trust owns the land in terms of sale deed, and as per PARA – II, the said trust owns the land in term of lease deed form 2017 to 2047. Therefore, it is not possible for the same trust to own the same piece of land in two ways. Hence, it cannot be ascertained, whether the trust hasowned the land in terms of sale deed or lease deed.	 Sri Vidya Vihar Educational Trust has own the land by sale deed on 13th Nov 2006. The Trust has given lease to Sri Vidya Vihar (CBSE) School upto 2047. Sri Vidya Vihar (CBSE) School has changed the name into "International Delhi Public School" on 29.12.2023. wef by Department of School Education, TamilNadu. At Present the land is utilized for "IDPS" Ambur upto 2047. Resolution has enclosed.
5.	The boundary wall is partially shown in the IC video, hence, continuity of the boundary wall from all sides cannot be ascertained. Further, there is a gap seen in the IC video at video ref time 0:09.	Boundary wall has constructed by all four sides with two gates.
6.	As reported by the IC, the school has obtained EPF number, however, it is yet to be contributed.	EPF has contributed from December 2024.
7.	The library is understocked and it does not have separate reading space for staff.	Library has equipped with more than 3000 titles. Teachers reading space has allocated.
8.	The school has not set up the composite science lab for the secondary level (in light of the Board's SoP).	As per Board guidelines, the composite science lab has been set up.
9.	The physics and chemistry labs have curtains, which may pose a fire	All the 3 labs. (Physics, Chemistry and Biology)

The Biology lab is temporarily set up on the desks with a few equipment. The school has shown only one CwSN toilet in the IC video (ref time 5:44), which does not have a door and the wall ofthe said toilet is not connected to the rooftop and does not allow any privacy to a CwSN. As per norms, the school shouldhave proper CwSN toilets separately for boys and girls with sufficient space for easy movement of the wheelchair as wellas handrails on both sides of the toilet seat (fixed and movable) and proper permanent signage as per norms of RPwD Actand board's guidelines. 13.	The IC video is not created in the continuity, the school has merged multiple photographers in the video due to which the continuity of the video is not being maintained in r/o the inspection day.	Technical Interruption Occurred
